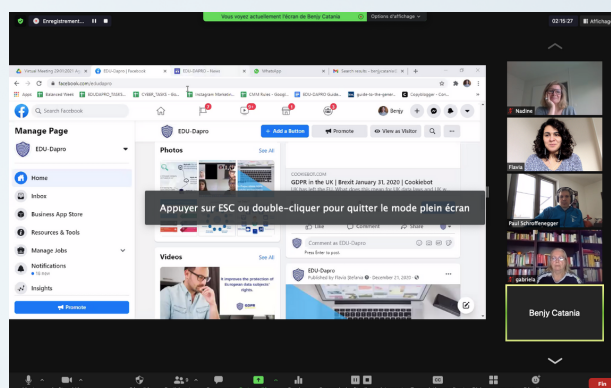

The EDU-DAPRO Pathway

Our main objective is to provide a comprehensive pathway for small and medium enterprises so that they can reach their objectives in terms of personal data protection and be compliant with the GDPR. Our outputs are conceived in a way to address all the aspects of GDPR-compliance process for small businesses. Here is the complete framework, as designed by the EDU-DAPRO experts:

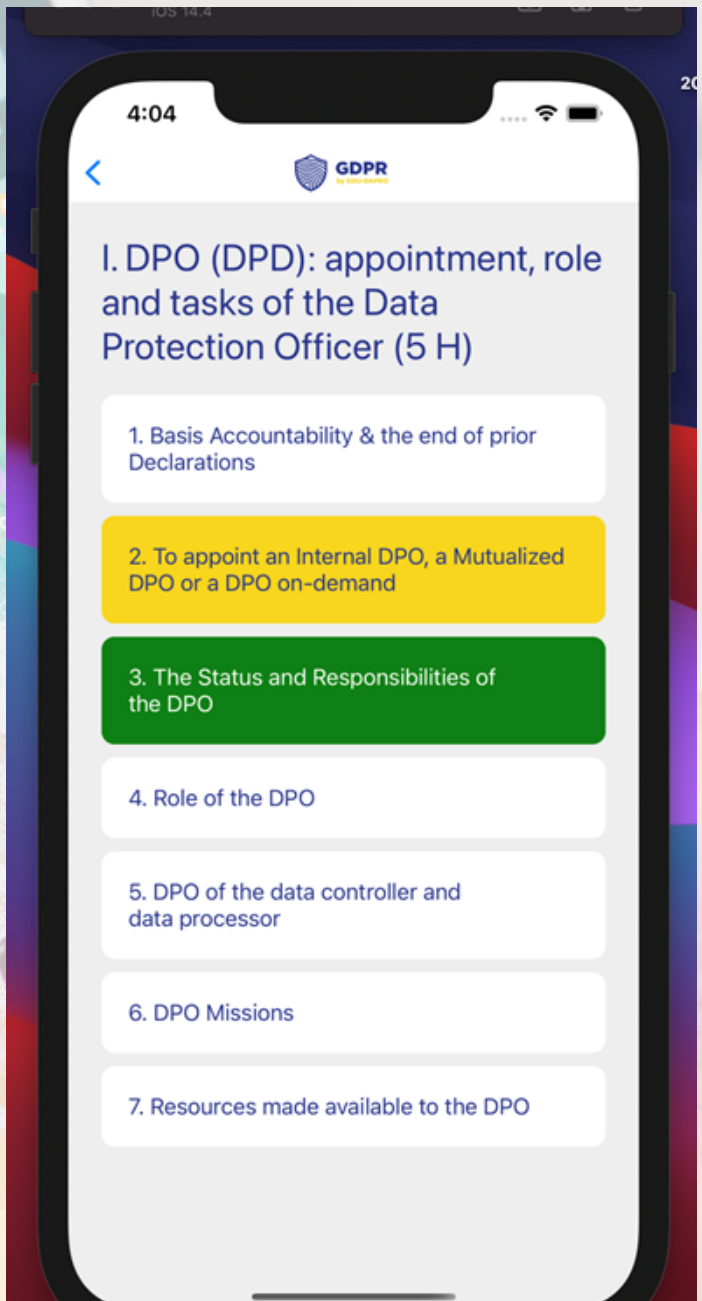
1. The Diagnosis Tool allows businesses to assess their compliance to data protection rules.
2. The e-Assessment Tool helps businesses determine if their staff is up-to-date with the GDPR and has the necessary knowledge to ensure data protection at all levels. The assessment quiz will help you spot the knowledge gaps and make recommendations for further training.
3. The mobile app completes the assessment tool, as it provides on-line training modules that address the knowledge, skills and competence needed for ensuring that the company or organisation is correctly protecting individuals' personal data.
4. A game-based approach, including a digital serious game and an espace game, completes our pathway. These games can be used by organisations to increase their staff's awareness on data security.
5. A Training Guide providing proposals for teaching methods and lessons designs to help trainers use the tools in an appropriate way.

IO3: Mobile App

For the moment, there are four versions available: English, Polish, German and French. The newest versions also contain the quiz questions, allowing the user to test their knowledge after each unit.

For the work on the linkage between IO2 and IO3 and the open badges, UTT, IFBI and IFPRA will hold a meeting beginning of October.

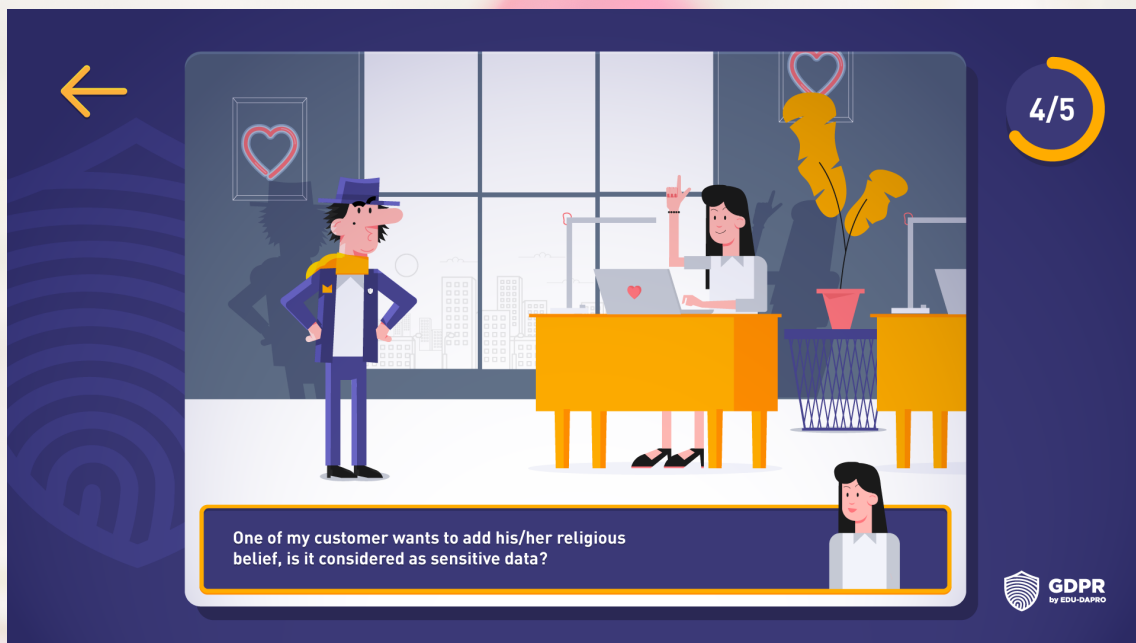
We will inform you when our new Mobile app is underway for operations.

Objectives: to bring the trainers together to further develop and evaluate the training outcomes. The event will commence in December in Malta. To register you can visit our website for a free 3 day event.

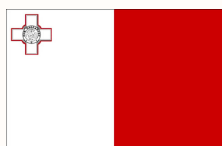
